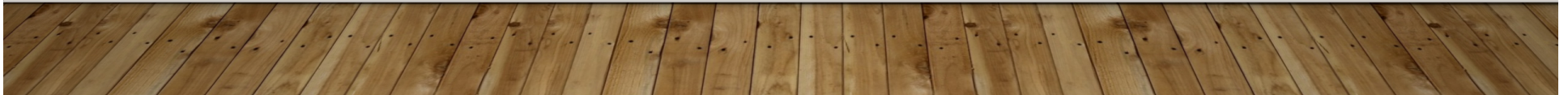

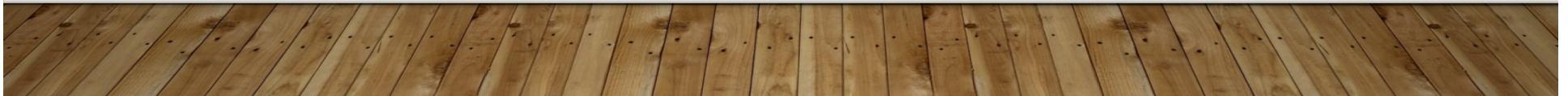

If you have song requests, you can send them to Bri who will prepare the videos and lyrics for the next time.

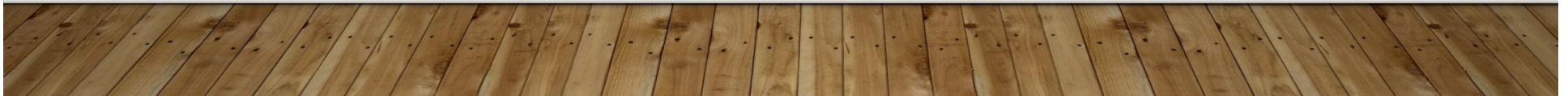
If you are interested in joining this group, please email us back ASAP and let us know! We would love if you could let us know by the end of this week! Once we know who is interested, we will schedule the first date!

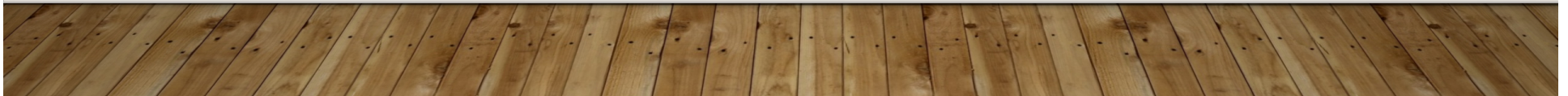

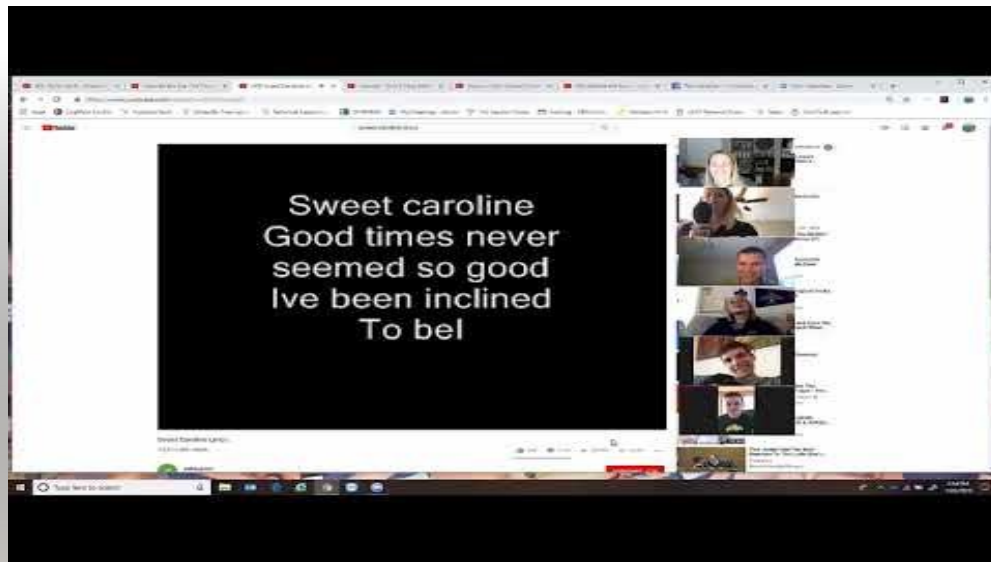
- Keeps group connected and engaged between meet-ups



“I like talking with everyone.” - Lauren

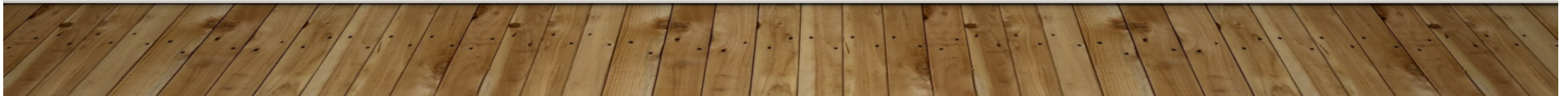
